AWARD AMOUNT

The amount awarded for this scholarship will be \$1000 - \$2500.

BASIC ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Must be a female and legal U.S. Citizen.
- Must be a current senior (or graduate) of an Erie County or Ottawa County, OH, high school.
- Must have a GPA of 2.5 or greater.
- Must be accepted (or enrolled) in a 2 or 4 year aviation related degree program at an accredited technical school, college or university.
- *Past scholarship recipients are encouraged to re-apply, provided they still meet all eligibility requirements.*

USES OF SCHOLARSHIP

- Tuition & books only (*Excludes room & board, general living expenses and flight training.*)
- Scholarship funds will be paid directly to the institution in the recipient's name.
